Card payments can now be made at RTIA office

The Road Traffic Infringement Agency's (RTIA) is now accepting card payments at the Agency head office in Midrand. This move forms part of the Agency's preparations for the imminent national rollout of AARTO. The card payment facility sees the Agency convenient payment platforms move to 2 667 following a deal clinched with major retailers including Spar and Shoprite in 2016.

The card payment system at the Road Traffic Infringement Agency (RTIA) allows road users to make payments using all major credit and debit cards. Payments can be made from 8:00 – 15:30 (including lunch time) on weekdays. Payments will reflect immediately after successful transaction.

Motorists will be able to pay their discounted penalty provided they do so 32 days after receiving the fine, pay for the fine in full or make instalment payments provided an arrangement has been made with the Agency.
