SECONDMENT OF MS MM MABULA AS ACTING REGISTRAR (CEO) FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORT

This serves to inform all Road Traffic Infringement Agency (RTIA) stakeholders that following the Agency's previous media statement issued on 05 February 2021 in respect to the precautionary suspension of officials at the Agency, the Board appointed Adv Mncedisi Bilikwana as an interim measure in order to allow the Department of Transport to identify an incumbent to be seconded to the Agency.

The Department of Transport has seconded Ms Dalian Mabula as an Acting Registrar (CEO) with effect from 15 February 2021 until the finalisation of the investigations, which were commissioned by the Board as reported on 05 February 2021.
