AARTO Education Awareness in Umsobomvu Municipality

The Road Traffic Infringement Agency (RTIA), in partnership with Umsobomvu Local Municipality inform the motorists and general public of the four-day AARTO Roadshow activation programme which will take place in the Colesberg from 15 -18 November 2022.

The RTIA is continuously reaching to motorists in vast remote areas of South Africa, to conduct Administrative Adjudication of Road Traffic Offences (AARTO) Public Education Awareness Campaign. The RTIA is taking AARTO services closer to the road user community.

The road users will be assisted to check their AARTO infringement status, and are advised on how to resolve the same AARTO infringements by selecting from the available legislated elective options.
